



Pre-War Prescott, Saturday 15th July 2023

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Before the day. For all who wish to climb the hill on Saturday (drivers AND passengers), you will need to obtain a MSUK Clubman license at <https://rsclubman.motorsportuk.org/>. It is free of charge and easy to obtain. Once you have it, print it out and bring a copy to Prescott (or have it on your mobile phone) on the day - you will need it if you wish to climb the hill.

Once you have obtained your license, you will also need to pre-register for the day with the BOC, using this link: <https://forms.gle/5hsY3ZBAyavcwrwG6>.

If, for any reason, you are unable to fulfil either of the above steps, you will be able to fill in an MSUK application form and pre-registration form in the office, but clearly, the more who have prepared in advance, the less delay and workload for the BOC staff on the day. Thanks for your understanding.

Before you can climb the hill, you will need to check at the BOC office where you will show your MSUK license, confirm you have registered and will receive your wristband which you will need to show to the start line marshal in order to enter the hill. All entered cars must be road legal and carry insurance.

2 Timings:

8-30 a.m.	Gates open
10:00 a.m.	The hill opens for morning runs
1:00 p.m.	The hill closes for lunch
1:30 p.m.	The charity auction
2:00 p.m.	The hill opens for afternoon runs
2:25 p.m.	The flypasts by the Spitfire and Hurricane
4:00 p.m.	The hill closes for the day
5:00 p.m.	Evening informal pub meet at the Gardeners Arms, Alderton (OS150/999334)

- 3 If you arrive as an entrant before the hill opens at 10:00 a.m., arrive at the Main Gate where your ticket will be checked and you will receive your free Programme. You will then be directed to the Paddock where each Club will have their parking area signposted. The Gate Marshals will have a map of the Paddock to assist you. The parking plan is not strictly enforced, but is aimed to help owners of similar marques to gather together in their own areas.
- 4 If you arrive as an entrant after 10:00 a.m., please present yourself at the Paddock gate (along the lane from the Main Gate). This is because the Main Gate access to the Paddock will be closed to allow cars to enter the start line from the Paddock.
- 5 If you are spectating, arrive any time after 8:30 a.m. at the Main Gate and you will be directed into the Orchard.
- 6 For climbing the hill, children in open cars with the hood down must be over 16 years of age and at least 1.35m tall with the age limit reduced to 12 for cars with the hood up. Saloon cars are fine for children so long as they are belted in according to normal road traffic regulations pertaining to booster seats. Very young children are discouraged as they are not able to support their own neck in an accident. All children also need to have a parent or guardian sign their indemnity form on the day at the BOC office. (This is all verbatim from the BOC.)
- 7 On the day, any queries regarding the event should be brought to the staff at the VMR Marquee. For any queries regarding climbing the hill or any other trackside issues, please ask one of the hill marshals or at the BOC office.

- 8 Racing helmets are not permitted as this is a non-competitive event.
- 9 No dogs are permitted anywhere onsite, including the Orchard. (This is a new BOC restriction).
- 10 For those planning to camp at Prescott over the weekend, camping will be available all weekend in the Orchard – from Thursday night to Sunday night inclusive. Camping should be booked through the Register and not through the Bugatti Owners Club. If you wish to camp or bring your camper van, please e-mail (vintageminor@gmail.com). Fees are £15 per night for campers and caravans, tents £10 per night. No extra charge for trailers. **IMPORTANT** please be aware that the Peugeot Sports Club of the UK (PSCUK) will be holding their day at Prescott on Sunday 16th and I am co-ordinating with them to ensure all goes smoothly over the weekend for both clubs. Some PSCUK members will be camping over the weekend and we will need all campers to pitch their tents or campers at the lower edge of the Orchard (along the gravel track). This will allow the PSCUK staff to stake out the main area of the Orchard on Saturday evening for their spectator parking requirements for Sunday.
- 11 Trailers. If you are bringing your car on a trailer, please arrive at the Main Gate. You can then bring your trailer into the Orchard for unloading and park it there for the day (or weekend) in the camping area (see above). You can then drive your pre-war car into the Paddock (directly before 10 a.m. or via the Paddock gate down the lane after 10:00 a.m.)

Please also note the following:

- 1 You are invited (but not required) to arrive in period dress, to add to the pre-war atmosphere of the day. The magnificent Pre-War Prescott Quaich will be presented to the winner of the best-dressed competition, who will also take home a small replica to keep permanently. You will be discretely judged during the day! To this end, we politely discourage dayglo motorsport garb, baseball caps, etc.
- 2 There will be a lunchtime auction of automobilia and memorabilia with 100% of funds raised going to the RAF Charitable Trust. Please bring along any quality items you would like to donate to the VMR Marquee in the morning. Thanks for your generosity and please gather at the Marquee by 1:30 p.m. if you wish to bid!
- 3 If you have any other questions or concerns regarding the day, please contact Ian at vintageminor@gmail.com before the weekend.
- 4 Vintage Minor Register members receive a £15 discount on their Pre-War Prescott entry. If you are not already a member, please consider joining on the day at the VMR Marquee where you will receive a £15 discount on your membership. Membership is open to owners and enthusiasts of ALL pre-war cars. This is an excellent way to support the Register and our events.
